1. To receive apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllr Connolly

2. To receive any declarations of interest

No declarations made.

3. To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 20th July 2016 and report on any matters arising

Cllr Lewendon proposed and it was seconded by Cllr Perkins and therefore **RESOLVED:** that the minutes of the meeting held on the 20th July 2016 be signed as a true record. All in favour.

4. To receive any matters raised by members of the public

5. To Report on Matters relating to the Recreation Ground

- Repair/Refurbishment of Play equipment the clerk advised that quotes had been sought for the works identified on the ROSPA reports however only one quote had so far been received.
- Paddling Pool The Clerk reported that following a problem with the drainage bung becoming stuck in the drainage pipe, a quote had been received in the sum of £875.00 for remedial works including excavate to remove the bung and provision of a new valve to provide for more efficient means of draining the pool. Members requested that the Clerk seek 2 further quotes.
- Consider provision of new signage The Chair reported that the Finance Officer was preparing a list of new signage to be provided at the Recreation Ground to consolidate the many old signs currently in place – once the list is complete quotes will be requested & reported to Amenities Committee.
 - The Chair then reported on correspondence received raising concern about canoes/boats that are launched from the Recreation Ground and the dangers once downstream at Bickton where sluices and a weir are located, the issue of river users exiting onto private land was also raised. Members acknowledged the concern and discussed whether the Council should provide

signage at the jetty in the Recreation Ground raising user's awareness. However, it was agreed that it is not the Council's responsibility to provide signage to this effect and river users should make themselves aware of any issues concerning the waterway which they are to use.

- Car Park & Access Road Surface The Clerk reported that although works had been undertaken, further works are required to address the direction of drainage (levels need to drain away from Rugby pitch and training area.)
- New Gate & Fencing Gate repositioned and fencing works partially complete, contactor to provide ramp from road. Issue with restricted access to the Whippet store needs to be resolved.
- Facilities & Pitch Maintenance The Chairman reported that the 2nd vertidrainage works had been completed on all pitches and the rugby club had undertaken the provision of 40 tonnes of top dressing to the training area. The Rugby Club had also purchased a new fertilizer spreader and had used this on the Brownsey pitch.

6. To report on any matters concerning Open Spaces

Nothing to report.

7. To report on any Tree Works

The Clerk reported that damage had been sustained to the shed in the Children's Play Area (Recreation Ground) caused by falling branches.

The Chair reported on a proposal received from the Sports Club for the conversion of the old toilet block into storage to be used by the Rugby and Football Clubs.
