## 9. To note any items of correspondence

The Assistant Clerk read a newsletter from Metis Homes in relation to their proposals at Burgate Acres, Fordingbridge. As part of their plans for this site, Metis Homes are proposing to facilitate the delivery of the following highways changes:

- Introduction of a T-junction at the Salisbury Road / A338 junction; to comply with current standards;
- Introduction of a new T-junction to the north of the new Salisbury Road / A338 junction to provide safe access to the proposed development, and to facilitate the school bus
- A new dedicated school bus link to the new junction (i.e. along Burgate Fields)

As part of their planning application, Metis Homes will submit a full transport assessment which will consider in detail the proposed highways and access arrangements. This transport assessment will be publicly available once submitted.

Councillors expressed concern over the proposed highways and access arrangements and considered the plans dangerous. The Council preferred a roundabout which would slow the traffic instead. Concern was also expressed over the removal of the existing slip road from Salisbury Road onto the A338. Cllr Jackson suggested that the Council may need to do their own traffic survey.

## Action: Clerk to request a copy of Metis Homes' Transport Assessment when available

Cllr Wilson asked whether the Town Council could draw up a supplementary planning document rather than a more detailed neighbourhood plan which would take longer and be more expensive to achieve. Cllr Jackson reported that the Council already has a supplementary planning document in the form of the Fordingbridge Town Design Statement. Cllr Wilson asked whether the existing design statement could be modified and whether the market town initiative is still valid. http://www.newforest.gov.uk/media/adobe/f/p/TDS Web.pdf
