To approve the repairs to the Youth Shelter

A quote has been received to replace all four clear sheets with 5mm polycarbonate sheeting £1100. The RFO reported that in April 2012 one replacement panel was supplied (but not fitted) by Broxap at a cost of £432.50. This panel was fitted by the Council's Groundsmen. In December 2013 Broxap replaced another panel at a cost of £1490. The quote of £1100 for all four panels to be replaced represents better value and the money is available in the budget to cover this expense.

Cllr Anstey proposed and it was seconded by Cllr Mouland and therefore **RESOLVED**: to nominate this sum of money for the repair of the youth shelter. All in favour.
