Proposed Works: Yew x 1 Reduce

Reason for Work: Reduce to 4ft above ground level to form new hedgerow.

Case Ref: CONS/23/0547

Site Address: The Millers House, 33 Provost Street, Fordingbridge, SP6 1AY

Proposed Works: Willow x 1 Reduce

Sycamore x 1 Fell Beech x 1 Reduce Ash x 1 Reduce

Reason for Work: T1 - Weeping Willow - This is to reduce overall weight of canopy due

to its location over river and it's unnatural lean.

T2 - Sycamore - One sided canopy with low amenity value.

T3 - Beech - Canopy is starting to become over dominant for its

surroundings and interfering with other species nearby.

T4 - Ash - Canopy is far too large for its surroundings and is

creating excessive shading.
